## 189 FAMILIES RECEIVE AID FROM TERENGGANU INC FLOOD RELIEF EFFORTS



8 January - Terengganu Inc successfully carried out a flood relief mission by distributing food baskets worth more than RM19,000.00 to 189 families affected by the flood in the Kuala Besut area.

With the cooperation of the Kuala Besut State Assembly Office and a team led by the wife of the Terengganu Menteri Besar, To' Puan Seri Tuan Faizah Tuan Abd Rahman, essential items such as rice, sugar, canned sardines, bread, biscuits, flour, and drinks were distributed.



## TDM PLANTATION RESPONDS TO FLOODS WITH RELIEF ASSISTANCE AROUND ESTATE AREAS



23 December - The floods that hit TDM Plantation Sdn Bhd (TDMP) estates and mills were characterised as the worst, affecting places that had never been inundated before.

The flood victims were forced to flee their homes and evacuate to relief centres without having ample time to save their belongings as the floodwaters rose drastically. The floods had cut off main roads and electricity and destroyed all possessions in a split second.

In response to the situation, the team led by TDMP Chief Executive Officer, Encik Hamdan bin Ibrahim, together with their operations staff, and Heads of Departments from TDM, had the opportunity to visit and render flood relief assistance. The assistance extended to the flood victims was one of the company initiatives, where a total of 44 families at Pinang Emas Estate and 86 families at Pelantoh Estate and Kemaman Palm Oil Mill received the donations.





## SATU ASSSIST FOUR DISTRICTS AFFECTED BY FLOOD
