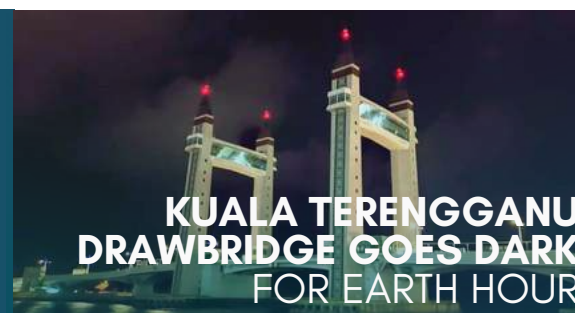
1,000 TREES TAKE ROOT IN TDM'S RELIFE PROGRAM
